WARREN, Mich. — All About Animals Rescue will host a Trap Neuter Return (TNR) training seminar on Sunday, October 13, 2019. Endorsed by the American Veterinarian Medical Association, this seminar will raise awareness about the efforts local residents can make in their community to reduce pet overpopulation and end needless euthanasia. Registration is not required, but appreciated for supply purposes. To register e-mail name and phone number to tnr@allaboutanimalsrescue.org. Seminar fee is \$10.

TNR seminar addresses the rapidly growing community cat population and offers a solution to reduce and stabilize it. Community cat caretakers are trained in trapping and managing community cats. Through the TNR program, community cats are trapped, brought to a veterinarian to be spayed or neutered, vaccinated, and ear tipped. After receiving these procedures, it's returned to the original neighborhood where it was found to live out a full non-reproductive life.

“This program is incredibly important,” said **SPEAKER NAME**. “We need to focus on community cats everywhere. Cats are territorial animals. When removed from an area, new cats will just move in and breed. So instead of bringing all these cats in and euthanizing them for simply living outdoors, we need to focus on stabilizing the population.”
